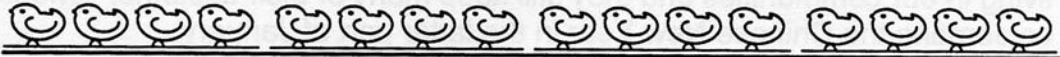


EASTER



This is one of the most important celebrations in our church as we celebrate the resurrection of Christ. Resurrection means rebirth, regaining health after a very serious illness or return from death.

Easter Bunny Flags

Make a large white circle (27 cm in diameter) from poster board or a cereal box covered with white paper or felt. Cut out grey hair, ears and cheeks, blue and black eyes and pink nose and mouth from same material you used for face. Assemble as shown below. Attach colored ribbons or crepe paper. These may be hung from the ceiling or along the wall for an attractive Easter decoration.



Easter Eggs: Shape Easter eggs, bunnies or chickens from your favorite marshmallow and rice crispy recipe. Decorate with edible stars, circle, etc.

Easter Flower Pots: Paint flower pots with spray, poster or enamel paint or cover it with bric a brac, scraps of tissue paper. Decorate with buttons or Easter decals. Transplant a small plant in the pot and take it to a nursing home or give it as a gift for a grandparent.

Easter Banners: Using washed cotton material about 45 cm by 90 cm or longer, draw and color Easter symbols with wax crayons all over the sheet. Cover the finished product with brown paper and iron. Glue a piece of doweling on the top and bottom and attach a gold or colored string at the top.
